The Whole Dam Family celebrates the historic relationship between Chateau Tanunda, the Barossa Valley and its generations of grape growers and winemakers who love nothing more than to let their hair down and kick up their heels. The old image on the front label of the local winemakers dressed up celebrating the Barossa Vintage festival is a tribute to this tradition.

Vineyard

This limited release is a selection of the The Whole Dam Family of French varieties that thrive in the Barossa climate: Shiraz (34%), Grenache (25%), Mourvedre (24%), Cinsault (11%) and Carignan (6%).

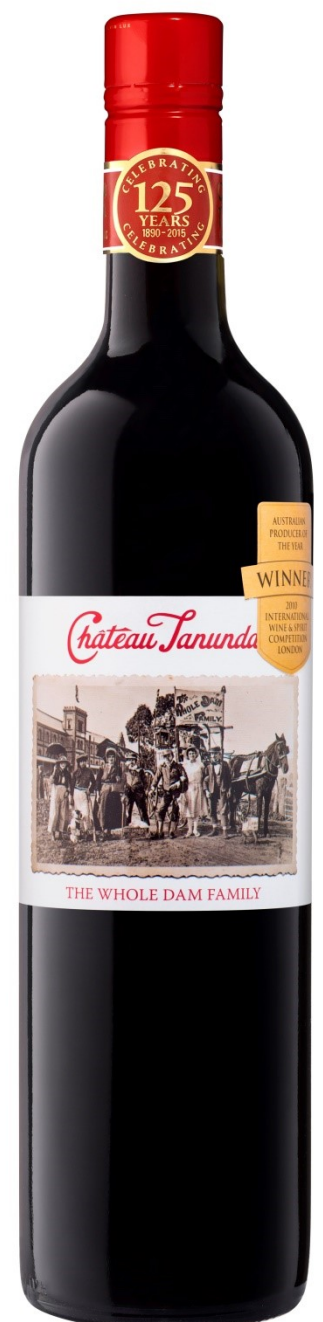
Winemaking

The individual grape parcels were picked, fermented, basket pressed and matured separately, spending nine months in a combination of new and seasoned American and French oak barrels.

Notes and Reviews

Medium bodied with aromas of strawberries, cherries and subtle spice. The palate is well balanced and highlights lifted flavours of vanilla, cinnamon, black olives and pepper. A vibrant and fresh wine with a long soft finish
