

## GRAND BAROSSA GRENACHE SHIRAZ MOURVÈDRE 2016

### Heritage

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine wine making spanning three centuries.

### Vineyard

For our Grand Barossa wines, we select grapes grown throughout the Barossa and its myriad of sub-regions. It is this tapestry of 'terroirs' which enables us to create our classic and refined house style.

### Winemaking

The skins were gently pressed and were matured for 16 months in a mixture of new and older French oak.

### Tasting note

This exciting blend of Grenache, Shiraz, Mourvèdre displays ripe aromas of blackberry, black cherry and raspberry flavours and accompanied by spicy, dark berry fruits and a hint of white pepper on the palate. The finish is long with fine grained tannins.
