

GRAND BAROSSA CABERNET MALBEC 2016

Heritage

Château Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa was established in 1890 and is the site of some of Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Château is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine winemaking spanning three generations.

Vineyard

For our Grand Barossa Cabernet Malbec we select grapes grown throughout the Barossa and its myriad sub-regions. It is this tapestry of 'terroirs' which enables us to create our classic and refined house style.

Tasting note

This enticing Cabernet Malbec blend show cases juicy black and red berry fruits, accompanied by earthy dark spice and fresh tobacco leaf. The finish is long with fine-grained tannins from eighteen months' maturation in a combination of new and seasoned French oak barrels. Although drinking well now this wine may be cellared for up to ten years from vintage.
